Pick-up for the Winter CSA is on Saturdays from 11 am until 4 pm at Lunar Rhythm Gardens, 253 Gray Rd. Janetville, L0B 1K0.

While members certainly share in the bounty of the garden, they also share in the risk. Every season offers us something new in terms of climactic conditions, which affects pests, diseases and overall plant health. This being said, while we aim to grow a wide variety of vegetables, we cannot guarantee any specific vegetables until we harvest them. We work within the boundaries set out by Mother Nature.

Your CSA bounty may include dried herbs and beans, hot peppers, winter storage radishes, parsnips, carrots, beets, potatoes, onions, winter squash, winter greens (ie. kale, lettuces, spinach), root parsley, cabbage, Brussels sprouts, leeks, garlic, kohlrabi, rutabagas, celeriac and sweet potato. Occasionally we are able to provide soaps, honey, pesto and frozen produce if they become available.

The pick-up dates are as follows: October 24, November 7, November 21, December 5, December 19, January 9 and January 23. Occasionally the weather may not be suitable for driving to the farm, in which case we will do our best to let you know by email, Facebook or phone.
